The FedRAMP authorization will provide federal fleets with access to bp pulse fleet's omega charge management software, which simplifies charging operations and manages fuel costs.

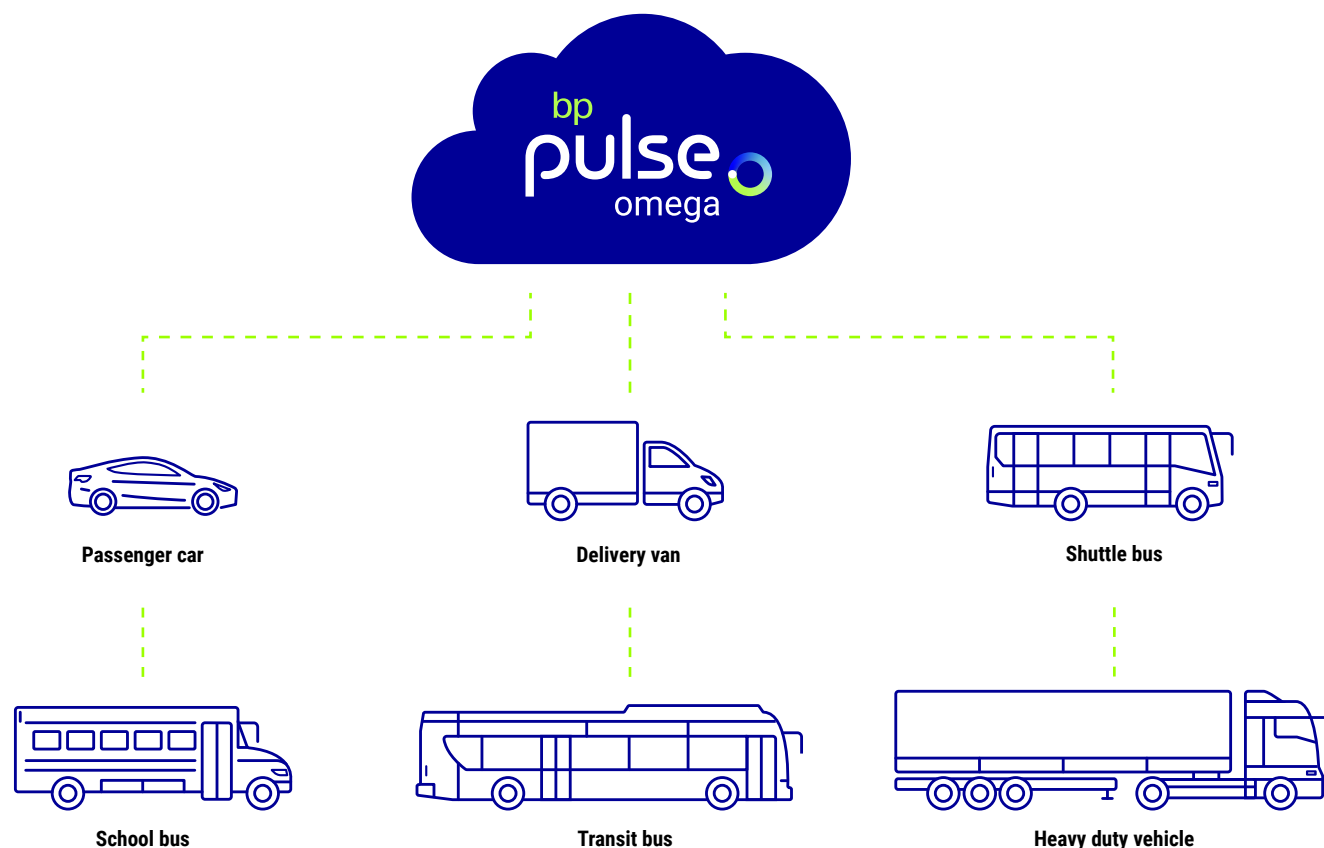
